Training

Training within Junior Chamber Dublin takes two forms:

- training evenings of 2/3 hours of detailed training on a particular subject
- short presentations made as part of the monthly General Meeting.

Training sessions cover a broad spectrum of topics, from personal development to understanding economic and social issues.

Business Programme:

Business Breakfasts:

These are social, interesting and informative meetings held once every two months. Prominent speakers from many walks of life are invited to speak on a topic of their choice, following breakfast in a city centre venue.

Dublin Training Day:

The aim of this project was to bring Junior Chamber training opportunities to the general public. The event was aimed at women in

supervisory positions, who feel that they have the potential to progress further.

Enterprise Award:

This project recognises and encourages the endeavours of young entrepreneurs throughout Ireland. The project has been run for the past 7 years and is sponsored by Ernst & Young. The winner receives a JCD/E&Y trophy, corporate membership of JCD and constancy services of £4,000 from Ernst & Young. It is a project which provides members with an opportunity to learn about the different aspects of business in Ireland.

Annual Dinner:

This is a formal dinner which is held at the end of the year. The work of members is recognised by the presentation of awards. Chapter and project guests are invited to attend in recognition of their contribution to JCD's success during the year.

Business Heritage Award:

The aim of this award is to recognise the significant contribution made by founders of present day Dublin businesses to the cultural and commercial fabric of our city. It involves a formal Dinner at which a perpetual trophy is presented to the recipient.

Alumni:

The Alumni was inaugurated to give recognition to those members who have made an outstanding contribution to the Chapter during their membership. Past Presidents of Dublin and Senators, conferred by Dublin, automatically qualify.

Investment Club:

The club provides members with the opportunity to learn about investing on the stock market by managing the Club's funds and with each member contributing a minimal monthly amount.

At each quarterly meeting, the Club's portfolio is examined and members decide whether to liquidate any existing holdings and/or whether to invest in new companies.

International Programme:

JCD is a member of a Euro Multi-Twin group, made up of chapters from 9 European countries. Members of each of the chapters meet twice a year to discuss topics of interest and to run joint projects. For 1996, the joint project is a JCD idea - to survey our members on their knowledge on the basics of the EU and to do a comparative analysis across all the member countries, including those countries which are not EU-members.

Schools Programme:

Schools Debating:

This aims to provide an introduction to formal debating to post Junior Certificate second level students. The competition encourages participants to think as a team and to present a unified approach to the topic for debate.

Schools Interviewing:

This aims to assist schools which organise 'mock' interviews for their students, by providing the schools with a panel of interviewers from different professions. This project is run in conjunction with the Dublin Chamber of Commerce's Schools Business Partnership.

Arts and Leisure Programme:

The aim of the programme is to organise a monthly event, which provides members with the opportunity to attend events which they might not necessarily attend by themselves or with their own friends. Events include trips to Art Collections, Opera, Classical Music, Theatre.

National Programme:

Debating and Public Speaking:

JCD enters this National programme each year to give members the opportunity of improving their skills in these areas.

Youth/Community Programme:

Interact:

Qualified architects, construction engineers and quantity surveyors must work together on projects, however as students they gain little exposure to each other's disciplines. This project provides students with the only opportunity during their college curriculum to interact on a joint project.

TOYP:

This project serves to recognise at Junior Chamber International level, The Outstanding Young Persons between the ages of 18 and 40 who exemplify, in one of ten specific categories, the best attributes of the world's young people. Each year JCD nominates entrants in a number of the categories.

Project Shamrock:

Shamrock pins are sold for £1 each during the week preceding St. Patrick's Day. The event raises funds for a different city charity each year.

Children's Fund-raising:

This fund-raising project raises funds for Barnardo's, National Children's Hospital and UNICEF through a number of activities throughout 1996. Activities have included a skip-a-lunch appeal, table quiz, and second hand book sale.
