

It having been agreed to affiliate with the Junior Chamber International when a National Council had been formed, it was decided to invite Cork Junior Chamber to join in making application to the XI World Congress for Ireland's affiliation to the Junior Chamber International.

The President, Vice-President and Hons Secretary were appointed as a deputation to meet the Cork Junior Chamber to discuss and make the necessary arrangements.

It was agreed that the expenses of the deputation would be a charge on the funds of the Junior Chamber.

It was noted:

(a) that application had been made (15/10/1956) to the Secretary General, Junior Chamber International for the necessary applications form and for a note of the amount of affiliation fee;

(b) that Cork Junior Chamber had been invited (17/10/1956) to join in making application for Ireland's affiliation to the Junior Chamber International.

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP FORM

An "Application for Membership" form was approved. It was decided that five copies of the application for membership form be sent to each member of the Council together with five copies of the names and addresses of the members of the Junior Chamber and five copies of the Objects for which the Junior Chamber is established.

MEMBERSHIP

Consideration was given to an application (14/10/56) from Mr. Patrick D. Cunningham, and it was agreed to forward the applicant the Application for Membership Form together with the names and addresses of the members of the Junior Chamber.

Consideration was given to a letter (17/10/1956) from Messrs. W. L. Woolfson stating that two members of the firm - Messrs. Louis Woolfson and Solomon Woolfson - would like to become members of the Junior Chamber. It was agreed to send to the firm Application for Membership Forms and a list of the names and addresses of the members of the Junior Chamber.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION

On the proposal of MR. Leo A. Callow, seconded by Mr. P. J. Loughrey, Jr., it was decided to fix the amount of the annual subscription at £3.3.0d (Three pounds and Three shillings)
